A RESOLUTION REQUIRING TRAFFIC TO STOP) RESOLUTION NO. <u>/5</u> ON WEST SHERMAN STREET AT ITS INTERSECTION) WITH 12th STREET, AND PROVIDING FOR THE) for 1974 ERECTION OF SUITABLE STOP SIGNS.)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON: WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1283, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs on Sherman Street at its intersection with 12th Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Stop signs shall be erected on West Sherman Street at its intersection with 12th Street, and said West Sherman Street is declared to be a stop street on both the East and West sides of 12th Street; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
