BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1283, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs on Third Street at its intersection with "A" Street and on "A" Street at its intersection with Second Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected on Third Street at its intersection with "A" Street, and said Third Street is declared to be a stop street on both the North and South sides of "A" Street; and stop signs shall be erected on "A" Street at its intersection with Second Street, and said "A" Street is declared to be a stop street on both the East and West sides of Second Street; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 22nd day of October, 1974.
