ERECTION OF SUITABLE SIGNS.

RESOLUTION NO. 20
for 1974

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

WHEREAS, the City Council has caused the study to be made of the traffic flow characteristics on West Sherman Street and intersecting 12th street; and


WHEREAS, the City council has determined that erection of yield signs on West Sherman Street at its intersection with 12th street will promote greater traffic safety: and


WHEREAS; such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon as follows:

Section 1. Yield signs shall be erected on West Sherman Street at its intersection with 12th street and said West Sherman Street is declared to be a Yield Right of Way Street on both the East and West side of 12th Street; and such designation is part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 8th day of January, 1974.
