
WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1283, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs on Grove Street at its intersection with Vine Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected on Grove Street at its intersection with Vine Street, and said Grove Street is declared to be a stop street on both the North and South sides of Vine Street; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
