

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON ESTABLISHING AND DETERMINING THE LOCATION AND INSTALLATION OF NEW STOP SIGNS, YIELD SIGNS, NO-PARKING SIGNS AND THE PAINTING OF CURBS DESIGNATING NO-PARKING ON HIATT STREET IN THE CITY OF LEBANON. ) RESOLUTION NO. 6 for 1974

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1283, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended stop signs, yield right-of-way signs, and no-parking signs on Hiatt Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A stop sign shall be erected on Hiatt Street at its intersection on the South side of Milton Street; a yield right-of-way sign shall be erected on Hiatt Street on the North and South sides of its intersection with Elmore Street; no-parking signs and control markings shall be established on the westerly side of Hiatt Street for the first 25 feet southerly from Elmore Street and from the first 25 feet northerly from Milton Street, and along the easterly side of Hiatt Street for the first 190 feet southerly from Elmore and for the first 210 feet northerly from Milton Street; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
