

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET PARKING ) RESOLUTION NO. 8  
AND CREATING A MAIL BOX DROP ONLY ZONE.) for 1975

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5(5), Ordinance No. 1283 (indexed 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended that the Post Office drop boxes be moved north to a point 20 feet south of the crosswalk at Second and Grant Streets, and that a No-parking, Mail Box Drop Only Zone be established from the intersection for approximately 40 feet along the west side of Second Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Post Office drop boxes shall be moved north to a point 20 feet south of the crosswalk at Second and Grant Streets, and a No-parking, Mail Box Drop Only Zone is established from the intersection for approximately 40 feet along the west side of Second Street; and no-parking signs and suitable control markings shall be erected or painted in the appropriate places on said street; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 8th day of April, 1975.
