

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET PARKING
IN THE CITY OF LEBANON.

RESOLUTION No. 15
for 1975

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1282 (indexed 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended that, except for a strip beginning at a point on the west side of Second Street 125 feet south from its intersection with Tangent Street and extending along the west side of Second Street a distance of 147 feet from said point, parking be eliminated on the west side of Second Street from Tangent Street to Rose Street; and on the west side of Williams Street from Wheeler Street to Grant Street; and on the south side of Vine Street from Main Street to Second Street; and on the west side of Second Street from Oak Street to Airport Road; and


WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Except for a strip beginning at a point on the west side of Sectond Street 125 feet south from its intersection with Tangent Street and extending along the west side of Second Street a distance of 147 feet from said point, parking is hereby prohibited on the west side of Second Street from Tangent Street to Rose Street; and on the west side of Williams Street from Wheeler Street to Grant Street; and on the south side of Vine Street from Main Street to Second Street; and on the west side of Second Street from Oak Street to Airport Road; and no-parking signs and suitable control markings shall be erected or painted in the appropriate places on said streets; and such

designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of
Lebanon, Oregon.
