EAST APPROXIMATELY 427 FEET; THE WEST SIDE OF
ELEVENTH STREET FROM ROSE STREET TO TANGENT
STREET; AND THE SOUTH SIDE OF OLIVE STREET FROM
SECOND STREET TO THIRD STREET.

RESOLUTION NO. 19
for 1975

WHEREAS the City Engineer filed herein plans, specifications and estimates for the construction of a sanitary sewer system in the below described area,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

That it is necessary and proper that a sanitary sewer system be installed between Tenth Street and Eleventh Street on Isabella Street, Carolina Street and Academy Street; East Grant Street from Existing manhole at Grant & Walnut Streets East approximately 427 feet; the west side of Eleventh Street from Rose Street to Tangent Street; and the South side of Olive Street from Second Street to Third Street.

That plans, specifications and estimates, including the probable total cost of said improvements and the amount thereof to be borne and paid by the owners of the adjacent or abutting property, such being the property especially benefitted thereby, and the amount thereof to be borne by the City, be and they are in all respects approved, ratified and affirmed.

That said improvements be, and they are hereby declared to be necessary and proper and for the best interests of the City of Lebanon.

That the City Recorder shall cause such notice of intention to make said improvements to be given as provided by the Charter

of the City of Lebanon, said notice to be given by posting notices thereof in five public places in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for a period of ten days, or by publication of said notice in a newspaper in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for a period of ten days.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 27th day of May, 1975.
