A RESOLUTION REQUIRING TRAFFIC TO STOP ON SHERMAN STREET AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH FIFTEENTH STREET; ON SHERMAN STREET AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH AIRWAY ROAD; ON AIRWAY ROAD AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH OAK STREET; AND ON MAPLE PLACE AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH AIRWAY ROAD, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF SUITABLE STOP SIGNS.

RESOLUTION NO. 25

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1283 (Indexed 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs on Sherman Street at its intersection with Fifteenth Street, on Sherman Street at its intersection with Airway Road; on Airway Road at its intersection with Oak Street, and on Maple Place at its intersection with Airway Road; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected as follows:

- (a) on Sherman Street at its intersection with Fifteenth Street, and said Sherman Street is declared to be a stop street on both the East and West sides of Fifteenth Street;
- (b) on Sherman Street at its intersection with Airway Road, and said Sherman Street is declared to be a stop street on the East side of Airway Road;
- (c) on Airway Road at its intersection with Oak Street, and said Airway Road is declared to be a stop street on the North side of Oak Street;
 - (d) on Maple Place at its intersection with Airway Road,

and said Maple Place is declared to be a stop street on the East side of Airway Road;

and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 26th day of August, 1975.
