RESOLUTION NO. 10
for 1976

WHEREAS the City Engineer has filed herein plans, specifications and estimates for the street improvement district for the paving of the streets hereinafter named and described,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:


That said plans, specifications and estimates for the paving of Eddie Street from Elmore Street South to end; South Main Road from the south line of the property of Timber Valley Dairy to 130 feet south of Cedar Drive; Downing Drive; Randall Street; David Drive; Post Street from Milton Street South to South line of Downing Addition; Harrison Street from Seventh Street east to end; *Third St. from Vine to Maple,* including the probable total cost of said improvements and the amount thereof to be borne and paid by the owners of the adjacent or abutting property, such being the property especially benefitted thereby, and the amount thereof to be borne by the City, be and they are in all respects approved, ratified and affirmed.

That said improvements be and they are hereby declared to be necessary and proper and for the best interest of the City of Lebanon.

That the City Recorder shall cause such notice of intentions to make said improvements to be given as provided by the Charter of the

City of Lebanon, said notice to be given by posting notices thereof in five public places in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for a period of ten days, or by publication of said notice in a newspaper in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for a period of ten days.
