

A RESOLUTION FOR FACSIMILE SIGNATURES.) RESOLUTION NO. 21  
for 1976

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON  
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the First National Bank of <sup>ORE</sup>~~Portland~~, as a designated depository of this City, be and it is hereby requested, authorized and directed to honor checks, drafts or other orders for the payment of money drawn in this City's name, including those drawn to the individual order of any person or persons whose name or names appear thereon as a signer or signers thereof, when bearing or purporting to bear the facsimile signature of the following:

Verla M. Olson

when accompanied by the signature of any other authorized signer, and The First National Bank of Oregon shall be entitled to honor and to charge this City for all such checks, drafts or other orders, regardless of by whom or by what means the facsimile signature or signatures resemble the facsimile specimens duly certified to or filed with the First National Bank of Oregon by the Administrator of this City.

Section 2. That these resolutions shall remain in full force and effect until written notice of the revocation thereof shall have been delivered to and received by said bank.
