A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET

PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON

AND PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION

OF PARKING METERS.

RESOLUTION NO. 25 for 1976

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (1)(h), Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended that parking meters be installed on the north side of Vine Street from Park to Second Street, Ash Street from Park to Second Street, Sherman Street from Park to the east line of alley between Second and Third Street, Grant Street from Park to the east line of alley between Second and Third Street, Maple Street from Park to Second Street, Second Street from Vine to Maple Street, Main Street from Vine to Oak Street and Park Street from Vine to Oak Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking meters shall be installed on the north side of Vine Street from Park to Second Street, Ash Street from Park to Second Street, Sherman Street from Park to the east line of alley between Second and Third Street, Grant Street from Park to the east line of alley between Second and Third Street, Maple Street from Park to Second Street, Second Street from Vine to Maple Street, Main Street from Vine to Oak Street and Park Street from Vine to Oak Street; and suitable markings shall be painted in the appropriate places on said streets; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
