RESOLUTION NO. 28

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5(5), Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs at the intersection of Seventh Street and "E" Street to form a four-way stop; and

WHEREAS such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected at the intersection of Seventh Street and "E" Street to form a four-way stop area; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
