

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO SHARING OF )  
STATE INCOME TAX REVENUES. )

RESOLUTION NO. 43  
for 1976

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon, due to many factors beyond its control, is in need of income tax revenue for financing City government and the municipal programs; and

WHEREAS, it is impractical for the City to enact its own isolated income tax law; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon has an existing income tax system and could equitably share a portion of such revenues with cities on a suitable formula basis;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, that the Council petitions the State of Oregon through its legislative and executive branches to enter into a state income tax revenue sharing arrangement with Oregon cities; and the City requests that it be consulted and given an opportunity to study and report to the State when the various formulas are considered for the allocation of funds.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 10<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1976.
