A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET PARKING) AND CREATING A CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE) FOR PEDESTRIAN LOADING.

RESOLUTION NO. 48 for 1976

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1283 (indexed 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended that a controlled parking zone for Pedestrian Loading only be established on the south side of Sherman Street beginning at the southeast corner of Park Street and extending thence east approximately 60 feet; and

WHEREAS such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The south side of Sherman Street beginning at Park Street and extending thence east approximately 60 feet, is declared to be a controlled parking zone for Pedestrial Loading only. Suitable control markings shall be painted in the appropriate places on said street, and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 22nd day of September, 1976.
