A RESOLUTION REGULATING TRAFFIC IN THE CITY OF LEBANON RELATING TO STOP SIGNS ON CERTAIN STREETS.

RESOLUTION NO. 56 for 1976

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 5, Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.5), the common council has designated the erection of stop signs on Airport Road at its intersection with 2nd Street to form a four-way stop; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 5, Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.5), the common council has designated the erection of stop signs on 2nd Street at its intersection with West Grant Street to form a four-way stop; and

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected at the intersection of Airport Road at 2nd Street to form a four-way stop area.

Section 2. Stop signs shall be erected at the intersection of 2nd Street at West Grant Street to form a four-way stop area.

Section 3. Sections 1 and 2 of this resolution are designated and are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
