A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET PARKING) RESOLUTION No. 12. IN THE CITY OF LEBANON. ) for 1977

WHEREAS, the City Administrator has recommended that parking be eliminated on a portion of S. Santiam Hwy. 20 lying North of Wheeler Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking is hereby prohibited along approximately 40 ft. of curbing on the West side of Santiam Hwy., North of the Southernmost driveway entering Santiam Hwy. at the property known as 191 N. Main and approx. 35 ft. of curbing on the West side of Santiam Hwy., North of the Northernmost driveway entering Santiam Hwy. at the property known as 191 N. Main. Said driveways located along the Easternmost property line of said property.

A suitable sign shall be erected and markings shall be painted in appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of <u>5</u> for and <u>0</u> against, and approved by the Mayor this <u>23</u> day of <u>March</u>, 1977.
