ON ROSE STREET.)

RESOLUTION NO. 16
for 1977

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5(5), Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs on Rose Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected on Rose Street as follows: On the northeast intersection of Rose and 11th Streets, stopping traffic on Rose Street as it approaches 11th Street; stop signs on the northwest and southeast corners of the intersection of Rose and 9th Streets, stopping traffic on 9th Street as it approaches Rose Street; and stop signs on the northwest and southeast corners of the intersection of Rose and 6th Streets, stopping traffic on 6th Street as it approaches Rose Street; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 6 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 11th day of May, 1977.
