

A RESOLUTION REGULATING TRAFFIC IN )

SIGNS ON SIXTH STREET. )

RESOLUTION NO. 21  
for 1977

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5(5), Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of Stop signs on Sixth Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected on Sixth Street as follows: On the Northwest intersection of Sixth Street and Walker Road, stopping traffic on Sixth Street as it approaches Walker Road; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 25th day of May, 1977.
