A RESOLUTION REGULATING TRAFFIC IN THE CITY OF LEBANON RELATING TO STOP SIGNS ON EDDIE STREET.

RESOLUTION NO. 22

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5(5), Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of Stop signs on Eddie Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected on Eddie Street as follows:

On the northwest and southeast corners of the intersection of Eddie
and Elmore Streets, stopping traffic on Eddie Street as it approaches

Elmore Street; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations
of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of <u>5</u> for and <u>O</u> against, and approved by the Mayor this <u>25th</u> day of <u>May</u>, 1977.
