A RESOLUTION REGULATING PEDESTRIAN ) TRAFFIC IN THE CITY OF LEBANON RELATING ) TO CROSSWALKS ON NORTH MAIN STREET. )

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1, Ordinance No. 1371 (compiled as 6-6.2), the Common Council has recommended the delineation of crosswalks on North Main Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of pedestrian traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: Crosswalks shall be installed on North Main Street at the intersection of Morton Street, controlling the movement of pedestrians in crossing the above named streets in the immediate area of the above named intersection; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
