

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET)
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON)

Resolution No. 29
for 1977

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be eliminated on a portion of Santiam Highway 20 lying North of Morton Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Parking is hereby prohibited along approximately 40 ft. of curbing on the West side of Santiam Highway, South of the Southernmost driveway entering Santiam Highway at the property known as 191 N. Main Street.

A suitable sign shall be erected and markings may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 6 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 13th day of July, 1977.
