A RESOLUTION REGULATING TRAFFIC IN ) THE CITY OF LEBANON RELATING TO STOP ) SIGNS ON N. MAIN STREET )

RESOLUTION NO. 33 for 1977

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs on North Main Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected on North Main Street as follows: On the Northwest corner of the intersection of North Main Street and Morton Streets, stopping traffic on North Main Street as it approaches Morton Street; and such designation is part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of <u>6</u> for and <u>0</u> against, and approved by the Mayor this 14th day of September, 1977.
