

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET)
PARKING AND ESTABLISHING A)
TAXI STAND IN THE CITY OF LEBANON)

Resolution No. 36
for 1977

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that public parking be eliminated and a taxi stand be established on a portion of Main Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Public parking is hereby prohibited along approximately 20 ft. of curbing on the West side of Main Street adjacent to 680 Main Street (Tax Lot #3101).

Section 2: A taxi stand is hereby established along approximately 20 ft. of curbing on the West side of Main Street adjacent to 680 Main Street (Tax Lot 3101). Said stand to be for the exclusive use of the holder of Lebanon's Taxicab license.

A suitable sign shall be erected in the appropriate place; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 6 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 28th day of Sept., 1977.
