RESOLUTION NO. 38  
for 1977

WHEREAS the Mayor and Council of the City of Lebanon deem it to be reasonable and proper to afford the electors of the City an opportunity to adopt a Council-Administrator form of government, it is, therefore, necessary that the Council submit to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon at an election to be held November 8, 1977, for their adoption or rejection, the proposed new Charter and repeal of the existing Charter, effective July 1, 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

Section 1. That the following proposition shall be forthwith filed with the City Recorder for submission by him to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon for their approval or rejection at a general election to be held on November 8, 1977.

Section (a). That the ballot title shall be as follows:

A proposition submitted to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon by its Common Council at the general election to be held on November 8, 1977, for the adoption or rejection of a new City Charter for Lebanon providing for a Council-Administrator form of government and repealing all the provisions of the present City Charter, to take effect July 1, 1978.

Section (b). That the proposition shall be as follows:

Shall the proposed new City Charter providing for a Council-Administrator form of government be adopted and all of the provisions of the present City Charter be repealed, to take effect July 1, 1978?

Section 2. That the Recorder shall publish and post notices of said election as provided by law, and said proposition shall be placed on the official ballot. The Recorder shall establish polling places, furnish supplies, and provide Judges and Clerks for said election, if necessary.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 6 for and 0 against,  
and approved by the Mayor this 28<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1977.
