



Resolution No. 41
for 1977

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Mayor and the City Attorney of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized and directed to enter into agreements with the State of Oregon, by and through its Department of Transportation, Highway Division, for installation of at-grade railroad crossing protection devices at the W. Rose Street crossing, Oak Street crossing, and Williams Street crossing. Actual installation of the railroad crossing protection devices shall be accomplished by the Southern Pacific Transportation Company and maintenance shall be as specified in the P.U.C. order.
