Resolution No. 42 for 1977

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1, Ordinance No. 1371 (compiled as 6-6-2), the Common Council has recommended the delineation of crosswalks on Fifth Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of pedestrian traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: A crosswalk shall be installed on Fifth Street at the Lebanon High School, controlling the movement of pedestrians in crossing the above named street in the immediate areas of the High School; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
