

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET)
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON)

Resolution No. 43
for 1977

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be eliminated on a portion of the East side of Fifth Street adjacent to Tax Lot 4700 of sheet A.D., Linn County Tax Maps and of the West side of Fifth Street adjacent to Tax Lot 100 of sheet A.C., Linn County Tax Maps.

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Parking is hereby prohibited along approximately 230 feet of curbing on the East side of Fifth Street adjacent to Tax Lot 4700 of sheet A.D., Linn County Tax Maps.

Section 2: Parking is hereby prohibited along approximately 260 feet of curbing on the West side of Fifth Street adjacent to Tax Lot 100 of sheet A.C., Linn County Tax Maps.

A suitable sign shall be erected and markings may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against, and 1 abstain
and approved by the Mayor this 26th day of October, 1977.
