RESOLUTION NO. 2
for 1977

WHEREAS, the Oregon Library Association expects to seek approval in the 1977 Legislative Assembly for:

- (a) minimal per capital state support for public libraries to augment city and county support, and
- (b) grants to encourage establishment of library services where none now exist;


and

WHEREAS, these state-appropriated funds would be used to stabilize and/or expand library services while maintaining local jurisdictional control of city and county libraries;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the City of Lebanon does hereby endorse and approve the above described proposal and urges its adoption and enactment by the 1977 Legislative Assembly.
