AS FOLLOWS:



C O N T R A C T

By and Between

Oregon District 4 Council of Governments

and

City of Lebanon

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 13th day of February, by and between Oregon District 4 Council of Governments (hereinafter called OD4COG) and City of Lebanon (hereinafter called Contractor) and shall cover the period from February 13, 1978 through June 30, 1978.

WITNESSETH:

I. Purpose of Agreement: The purpose of this agreement is to Renovate present restroom facilities to provide adequate wheel chair and handicap access and use to be in compliance with the architectural barriers act as described in the attached plan.

The funds were awarded to OD4COG by the Oregon State Program on Aging under Public Law 94-135, the Older Americans Act, as amended 1975.
