SIGNS ON NINTH STREET AND ON MORTON )

Resolution No. 17  
for 1978

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs on Ninth Street and on Morton Street; and


WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected on Ninth Street as follows: A sign shall be placed on the Northwest and on the Southeast corners of the intersection of Ninth and Isabella; stopping traffic on Ninth Street as it approaches that intersection; and

Section 2. Stop signs shall be erected on Morton Street as follows: A sign shall be placed on the Northeast and the Southwest corners of the intersection of Morton and Hansard; stopping traffic on Morton Street as it approaches that intersection; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor/<sup>pro tem</sup>this 8<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1978.
