Resolution No. 23 for 1978

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of Stop signs on Harrison Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Stop signs shall be erected on Harrison Street as follows: A Stop sign shall be placed at the southwestern corner of the intersection of Harrison and Hansard Avenue, stopping traffic on Harrison Street as it approaches the intersection; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
