RESOLUTION NO. 24
for 1978

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of Stop and Yield signs on Aspen, Lupine, Larkspur, and Trillium Place Streets; and

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop and yield signs shall be erected on Aspen, Lupine, Larkspur, and Trillium Place Streets as follows:

- A) A stop sign shall be placed at the Southwestern corner of the intersection of Aspen Street and Vaughn Lane, stopping traffic on Aspen Street as it approaches the intersection.
- B) A stop sign shall be placed at the Southwestern corner of the intersection of Lupine Street and Honeysuckle Street, stopping traffic on Lupine Street as it approaches the intersection.
- C) A stop sign shall be placed at the Southeastern corner of the intersection of Lupine Street and Larkspur Street, stopping traffic on Lupine Street as it approaches the intersection.
- D) A stop sign shall be placed at the Southwestern corner of Larkspur Street and Columbine Street, stopping traffic on Larkspur as it approaches the intersection.

E) A yield sign shall be placed at the Southeastern corner of the intersection of Aspen Street and Honeysuckle Street assigning thru right-of-way as it approaches the intersection of Honeysuckle Street.

F) A yield sign shall be placed at the Southeastern corner of the intersection of Trillium Place and Violet Street, assigning the thru right-of-way to Violet Street traffic and causing Trillium Place traffic to yield the right-of-way as it approaches Violet Street; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 6 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 12th day of April, 1978.
