RESOLUTION NO. 25
for 1978

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1283 compiled as 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of a "NO RIGHT TURN" sign on Santiam Highway; and

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. "NO RIGHT TURN" sign shall be erected on Santiam Highway as follows: The sign (Rl-3a) shall be erected at the southernmost fork of the northernmost entrance to Champion Building Products plant in such a fashion as to prohibit right turns from the entrance onto the highway (i.e. prohibit west bound to north bound movement); and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
