TO STOP AND YIELD SIGNS ON GARVORD )  
STREET AND PARK DRIVE. )

RESOLUTION NO. 26  
for 1978

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop and yield signs on Garvord Street and Park Drive; and

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop and yield signs shall be erected on Garvord Street and Park Drive as follows:


- A) A stop sign shall be placed at the northeastern corner of Garvord Street and River Road, stopping traffic on Garvord Street as it approaches River Road.
- B) A stop sign shall be placed at the northwestern corner of Park Drive and Garvord Street, stopping traffic on Park Drive as it approaches Garvord Street.
- C) A stop sign shall be placed at the northeastern corner of Park Drive and Garvord Street, stopping traffic on Garvord Street as it approaches Park Drive.
- D) A yield sign shall be placed at the southwestern corner of Garvord Street and Glenwood Street, assigning the thru right-of-way to Glenwood Street traffic and causing Garvord Street traffic to yield the right-of-way as it approaches Glenwood Street; and

such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon,  
Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against, and
