A RESOLUTION REGULATING TRAFFIC IN THE CITY OF LEBANON RELATING TO STOP SIGNS ON THIRD STREET AND "B" STREET.

RESOLUTION NO. 31

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of Stop signs on Third Street and "B" Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Stop signs shall be erected on Third Street and "B" Street as follows:

- A. A stop sign shall be placed at the Southeast corner of Sherman and Third Streets, stopping traffic on Third Street as it approaches the intersection.
- B. A stop sign shall be placed at the Northeast and Southwest corners of "B" and Fourth Streets, stopping traffic on "B" Street as it approaches the intersection; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 4 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 14<sup>th</sup> day of 3une, 1978.
