Resolution No. 38
for 1978

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that guidelines be established for a sanitary sewage industrial cost recovery system in the City of Lebanon; and

WHEREAS, such guidelines are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the proper operation of the wastewater collection system in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: At such time as industrial wastes are defined under Section 35.905-8 of the Construction Grant Regulations 40 CFR, Part 35, are discharged to the facilities constructed under E.P.A. GRANT NO. C410446, the City shall develop and adopt an industrial cost recovery system acceptable to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. This cost recovery system shall comply with the requirements of P.O. 92-500 and all regulations and all regulations and guidelines pertaining thereto.


Section 2: In the interim, the City shall submit an annual certification affirming the non-existence of industrial discharges to this facility and shall maintain such records and documents as necessary to substantiate the certification.
