RESOLUTION NO. 52
for 1978

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 1283, the City Engineer has recommended the erection of stop signs on 11th Street and on 15th Street; and,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that existing stop signs at the intersection of 15th Street and Sherman Street be removed; and,

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Stop signs shall be erected on 11th Street as follows:

A sign shall be erected on the Northwest corner of the intersection of 11th Street and Sherman Street stopping traffic on 11th Street as it approaches the intersection.

Section 2: Stop signs shall be removed and erected on 15th Street as follows: The existing signs at the Northeast and Southwest corners of the intersection of 15th Street and Sherman Street shall be removed, thereby returning the intersection to the status of an "uncontrolled intersection." New stop signs shall then be erected on the Northwest and Southeast corners of the intersection of 15th Street and Sherman Street stopping traffic on 15th Street as it approaches the intersection and assigning the thru right-of-way to Sherman Street; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

and approved by the Mayor this 11 day of October, 1978.
