RESOLUTION NO. 53
for 1978.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON,
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It is hereby declared to be the policy of the Lebanon City Council to reconsider its decisions made at a prior meeting only in limited situations and after certain procedures have been followed.

Section 2. Any person or organization seeking reconsideration by the Council of a prior Council decision must file a written application setting forth the circumstances which have changed since the time of the original decision which would justify reconsideration. Said written application must be filed with the City Recorder, who shall then obtain staff recommendations and present the same to the Council.

Section 3. The City Council shall review the written application and the staff recommendations and determine whether or not circumstances have changed justifying reconsideration. If no such changed circumstances are apparent, the Council shall direct the City Recorder to notify the applicant that the previous decision shall stand. If, however, changed circumstances are apparent, the Council shall place the matter on the agenda for a future Council meeting.


Section 4. This resolution shall not prevent the Council from reconsidering prior decisions on its own or upon request of the City Administrator.
