

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET )  
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON. )

Resolution No. 55  
for 1978

WHEREAS, The City Engineer has recommended that parking be regulated on a portion of Park Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Parking is hereby prohibited along approximately 70 ft. of curbing on the west side of Park Street, south of the intersection of Sherman Street; and


Section 2: Parking is hereby controlled and limited to 15 minute parking between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. along approximately 46 ft. of curbing on the west side of Park Street, starting at a point 70 feet south of the intersection of Sherman Street; thence running south.

Suitable signs shall be erected and markings may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 6 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of November, 1978.
