
WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.5), the City Engineer of the Common Council has recommended the erection of Stop signs on Kari Place; and

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A stop sign shall be erected at the S.W. corner of Kari Place and South Main Road stopping traffic on Kari Place; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
