A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET )
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON )
ON WALKER ROAD AND 10TH STREET. )

Resolution No. 57 for 1978

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be eliminated on a portion of Walker Road and 10th Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1:</u> Parking is hereby prohibited along approximately 1550 feet of curbing on the east side of 10th Street between Vaughan Lane and the northwest corner of Lot 20, Block 3 Hood View Estates.

<u>Section 2</u>: Parking is hereby prohibited along approximately 1730 feet of curbing on the south side of Walker Road between Stoltz Hill Road and 7th Street.

A suitable sign shall be erected and markings may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of <u>5</u> for and <u>O</u> against, and approved by the Mayor this <u>13th</u> day of <u>December</u>, 1978.
