A RESOLUTION REGULATING PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC IN THE CITY OF LEBANON RELATING TO CROSSWALKS ON 5TH STREET AT LEBANON UNION HIGH SCHOOL.

Resolution No. 59

WHEREAS, purusant to Section 1, Ordinance No. 1371 (compiled as 6-6-2), the Common Council has recommended the delineation of crosswalks on 5th Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of pedestrian traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Crosswalks shall be installed on 5th Street at Lebanon Union High School, according to the attached sketch, controlling the movement of pedestrians in crossing the above named streets in the immediate area of the High School; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
