

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET)
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON.)

Resolution No. 60
for 1978

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be eliminated on a portion of the East and West sides of 5th Street adjacent to the Lebanon Union High School; and


WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Parking is hereby prohibited along approximately 210 L.F. on the West side and 330 L.F. of the East side of 5th Street as indicated on the attached sketch adjacent to the Lebanon Union High School.


A suitable sign shall be erected and markings may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
