

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET)
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON)

Resolution No. 1
for 1978

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be eliminated on a portion of Franklin Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Parking is hereby prohibited along approximately 120 ft. of curbing on the East side of Franklin Street, South of Milton Street and along approximately 190 L.F. of curbing on the West side of Franklin Street, South of Milton Street.

Section 2: Parking is hereby eliminated on both sides of Franklin Street North of Milton along approximately 20 ft. of curbing.

Suitable signs shall be erected and markings may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 6 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 11 day of Jan., 1978.
