Resolution No. 4  
for 1978

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (5), Ordinance No. 1283 (compiled as 6-4.5), the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of 4-way stop signs on Franklin and Elmore streets, and;

WHEREAS, such regulations are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: 4-way Stop signs shall be erected at the intersection of Franklin Street and Elmore Street at the northeast, northwest, southeast and southwest corners.


Section 2: Said signs shall stop traffic on both Franklin Street and Elmore Street as it approaches their intersection;

and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 1 against, and approved by the Mayor this 25th day of January, 1978.
