

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON.)

RESOLUTION NO. 34
for 1980

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be regulated on a portion of Oak Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking is hereby prohibited along both sides of Oak Street between Park Street and Main Street.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted in appropriate places prohibiting parking; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 24th day of September, 1980.
