RESOLUTION NO. 35
for 1980

WHEREAS the Common Council of the City of Lebanon did on May 24, 1978 pass Ordinance No. 1684 granting to Spady-Redfield Corporation, an Exclusive Franchise to Collect, Transport, and Convey Solid Waste over and upon the streets of the City and providing that the rates for such service under said Franchise shall be established by Resolution of the Common Council, and

WHEREAS new rates have been proposed by said Franchisee and good reason shown therefore; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

That the Franchisee shall charge for his services in the City in collecting said solid waste and debris according to the schedule attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof, said rate schedule to be in effect as of October 1, 1980.
