

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET)
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON)

RESOLUTION NO. 37
for 1980

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be regulated on a portion of Main Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking is hereby limited for a period of time not to exceed ten (10) minutes for each instance of use for the following described portion on the west side of Main Street: The first parking stall north of the yellow-painted no parking zone in front of the American Legion Club 51, more completely described as follows:

A parking area on the west side of Main Street beginning 51 feet north of the centerline of Vine Street right-of-way and extending north therefrom 18 feet.

Suitable signs shall be erected in appropriate places designating a ten (10) minute limit for parking and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by Council by a vote of 3 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 10th day of December, 1980.
