

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET) Resolution No. 1
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON) for 1980

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be eliminated on a portion of Dewey Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Parking is hereby prohibited along 50 feet of the South side of Dewey Street, East of Santiam Highway.

Suitable signs shall be erected and markings may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 4 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 23rd day of JANUARY, 1980.
